9th BioLux Network Meeting

We have the great pleasure to invite you to our monthly organised BioLux Network meeting which will be held **next Tuesday, the 23rd of November.**

We are very pleased to announce that we were contacted by SEBASTIEN GABEL, a PhD student from the University of Luxembourg, who has finished his PhD work and will defend his thesis very soon. Next Tuesday, Sebastien will share with us his research results and present his thesis called “*Inflammation-induced dedifferentiation of astrocytes and anti-inflammatory effects of undifferentiated neural cells*”. His PhD work is divided into two main sections: one part consists in the study of astrocytes dedifferentiation under inflammatory conditions and the second part deals with the anti-inflammatory effects of these dedifferentiated cells as well as progenitor cells on microglial cells during inflammation.
